She can't remember how long she has been making quilts, but she started with the Bethel Quilting group several years ago (See photos below of some past quilters). Seven years ago, Lois be-

gan sewing the quilts in her home. Her sewing machine is always set up and ready to sew! You will always find a quilt top in the making nearby. Lois and Chuck have worked together on 79 quilts since October 2022! That averages ten quilts per month! What a team!

Thank you, Lois and Chuck, for the endless hours you put into making these quilts for those who need them. Ten quilts were delivered to the Marie Sandvik Center in Minneapolis, and they received them with gratefulness. The other 24 are on their way to Sharing and Caring Hands (Mary's Place), also in Minneapolis.

The Bethel Quilting group (Deo Gloria Guild) has also been busy working on several quilts for those in need, GLLM Quilt Auction, and for Bethel's baptisms and graduates. Thank you for your creativity and dedication to this ministry!


3. Bethel offering envelope

<u>Council Members Present</u>: President: Ron Foust; Secretary: Cathy Houg; Treasurer: Matt Krull; Financial Secretary: Stacy Meyer; Finance Board: Mitch Overbye and Sara Jepsen; Education Board: Pete Hallberg and Emily Koehler; Trustee Board: Brian Duncan and Bryon Weisenburger; Vicar Stefan Swanson

<u>Call to Order and Opening Prayer</u>: The meeting was called to order by President Ron Foust at 6:30 p.m. Vicar Swanson opened the meeting with prayer.

Council Business:

- A motion was made by Cathy Houg and seconded by Mitch Overbye to accept the agenda as presented.
 Motion carried.
- Vicar Swanson reported that, in the last month, three Mission Assessment Focus Groups met. The summary report of the focus groups is nearly complete. It will be shared with the Assessment Team soon and then the congregation on May 21, 2023. Vicar attended a First Call Education opportunity at Gustavus Adolphus. He made a visit to a member of the congregation who is unable to attend worship.

Old Business:

- A **motion** was made by Mitch Overbye and seconded by Sara Jepsen to extend the agreement with Resplandor de Gloria at the same fee. Motion carried.
- A job description for the Audit Committee members is in progress by the Finance Board.

New Business:

• A presentation was given by Emily Koehler about the starting of a community garden in the lot west of the church. A **motion** was made by Ron Foust and seconded by Brian Duncan to initiate a committee to begin planning this project with \$250 from the Outreach Fund as seed money. Motion carried.

<u>Secretary Minutes</u>: A motion was made by Sara Jepsen and seconded by Stacy Meyer to accept April's secretary's report. Motion carried.

<u>Treasurer Reports</u>: A **motion** was made by Cathy Houg and seconded by Bryon Weisenburger to accept April's treasurer's report Motion carried.

<u>Financial Secretary Report</u>: A **motion** was made by Mitch Overbye and seconded by Sara Jepsen to accept April's financial secretary's report.

Board Reports:

- Education Board: The last day of confirmation and Sunday School will be May 21, 2023. There will be a Pizza Tip Night on May 22, 2023. The Sunday School will sing on Mother's Day.
- Finance Board: The agreement with Resplandor de Gloria is in place.
- <u>Trustees</u>: A cleanup day is being planned. A sign-up sheet is in the Narthex to complete a variety of spring projects. <u>Roof update</u>: An additional insurance claim will be placed to cover the hail damaged downspouts and gutters per the roofing contractor. A **motion** was made by Sara Jepsen and seconded by Pete Hallberg to use money from the Equipment Replacement Fund to cover any further expense not covered by insurance in replacing the remaining gutters and downspouts not to exceed \$2000 per the quote from the roofing contractor. Shingle replacement work, gutters, and downspouts will be coordinated together once everything is resolved with the insurance company. Motion carried.

The final report from the focus groups will be presented on **May 21, 2023**, after the Sunday Worship Service.
- Bethel will be serving at the Prairie Days' Burger Stand on Saturday, July 15, 2023, from 1-3 p.m. Ron Foust, Nicole Weisenburger, Mitch Overbye, Sara Jepsen, Bryon Weisenburger, Cathy Houg, and Carolyn Barr have volunteered to help. More volunteers would be nice.
- Organ Update: The down payment check has been sent and contract signed. The Organ Committee will coordinate the installation date and training session.
