Driving Away Hunger-MEFS Mobile Outreach

Driving Away Hunger aims to address transportation and mobility issues related to food access in our communities. Our Mobile Outreach vehicle is stocked with shelf-stable pantry items, fresh produce, frozen proteins, dairy, grains, and bakery goods. Please remember to place your orders before the delivery dates, as all will be pre-packed during the winter months. A limited number of walk-up portions will be available at each delivery site. Our staff will assist anyone who is unable to safely enter the vehicle for shopping. However, staff members are not allowed to carry food inside a residence. Full grocery distributions are available once a month per household, and you may visit different distributions sites once per week. All sites are open to the public. Go to

<u>WELCA Easter Project</u>

During the Easter season, WELCA will facilitate a collection of specific food items to donate to the McLeod County Common Cup Ministry. We encourage you to bring applesauce (cups or pouches), instant breakfast bottles, juice boxes, and fruit cups and place them in the collection containers in the narthex. These items support the Weekend Food Program, which assists McLeod County families in need. Children who qualify for the program receive a bag of food at the end of each week to take home, helping to supplement their meals over the weekend when they are not in school and unable to benefit from school lunches and breakfasts. Since November, several Bethel members have been packing and delivering these food bags to the Lester Prairie school for local students. 

Council Members Present: President: Dave Gohl, Secretary: Julie Hanson, Treasurer: Jill Duncan, Financial Secretary: Stacy Meyer, Finance Board: Mitch Overbye and Sara Jepsen, Education Board: Pete Hallberg and Katie Radtke, Trustee Board: Jeff Hanson and Bryon Weisenburger.

Call To Order: The meeting was called to order at 6:01 P.M. by President Dave Gohl followed with prayer by Pastor Molly Wills.

Council Business:

A **motion** was made by Sara Jepsen and seconded by Bryon Weisenburger to approve the agenda. **Motion** carried.

- Pastor Molly: Visited our homebound.
- Organized speakers for Wednesday Lenten services.
- Planned Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Services along with our May 4th service.
- Attended a First Call Pastor meeting.
- Attended our Crow River Conference meeting for those who help youth. There is a free 2B Continued Youth mental health first aid and training meeting on May 5th from 9:00 A.M to 3:30 P.M.at Gethsemane Lutheran Church in Dassel, MN. For registration information, look on the bulletin board.
- Attended Iris's 95th birthday party.

Old Business:

- Easter brunch last year served approximately 100. This year we need more food so we don't run out. More egg bakes, French toast and muffins will be provided.
- Finance committee on Stewardship funds reported that about one half of the pledge cards have been returned. Members need to be informed and or refreshed about the options of giving to the church.
- Cleaning crew: needs to make a new list of duties and or job description.
- Internet service: There have been over 300 views of our service a week.
- Internet provider: There is a need for faster internet. The quality would be better for streaming. A quote was presented from Metro Net for a three-year contract at \$126.55 plus cable installation. At this time Century Link is the provider at \$249.00. A **motion** was made by Sara Jepsen and seconded by Bryon Weisenburger to approve Metro Net to be the provider. **Motion carried**.

New Business:

- Paper shredding: Paper shredding available in Lester Prairie on April 19th. At this time there is not enough time to go through all that needs to be shredded. The alternative would be to take the paper to Hutchinson Recycling as they shred paper there also.
- Parking lot: There are three \$10,000.00 CD's at 1st Community Bank in Lester Prairie. These can be borrowed against them for a line of credit. Donations go back in to pay back the CD's. A motion was made by Sara Jepsen and seconded by Pete Hallberg to approve the line of credit. Motion carried.
- Spiritual Practices: Pastor Molly has provided spiritual practices. Discussed whether to continue or not. Exercising options at this time.
- Next council meeting changed to May 19th at 6:00 P.M.

Secretary Minutes:

• A **motion** was made by Bryon Weisenburger and seconded by Stacy Meyer to approve the secretary minutes from March. **Motion carried**.

Treasurer Report:

A motion was made by Sara Jepsen and seconded by Bryon Weisenburger to approve the treasurer report.
 Motion carried.

Financial Secretary Report:

A motion was made by Mitch Overbye and seconded by Sara Jepsen to approve the financial report.
 Motion carried.

Board Reporting:

- Education: Still in the process for gathering material (s) to share for Vacation Bible Study.
- Finance: Met with 1st Community Bank with cash flow discussion for the parking lot.
- Trustees: Cork board installation in the Narthex in process and almost complete. Materials for the solar panels for the church sign by the county road will be installed in May. Windows will be checked so they won't feel stuck when trying to open.

The meeting closed with round table prayers and the Lord's Prayer.
